The M62 Motorway and the A63 Trunk Road (Howden Interchange to Southcoates Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians) Order 2013

 Made
 26th June2013

 Coming into force
 30th June 2013

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway, the A63 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the East Riding of Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway, that trunk road and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing and routine maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway and the A63 Trunk Road (Howden Interchange to Southcoates Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 30th June 2013.

2. In this Order: -

"the M62" means the M62 Motorway;

"the A63" means the A63 Trunk Road;

"the eastbound carriageway" means the M62 and the A63 eastbound carriageways from the nose of the eastbound exit slip road at Junction 37 (Howden Interchange) to its junction with the A1033 Southcoates Roundabout, a distance of approximately 41700 metres;

"the westbound carriageway" means the M62 and the A63 westbound carriageways from its junction with Southcoates Roundabout to the nose of the M62 westbound entry slip road at Junction 38 (North Cave Interchange), a distance of 34700 metres;

"a slip road" means any of the following slip roads:

- (i) the M62 eastbound entry and westbound exit slip roads at Junction 37;
- (ii) the M62 eastbound entry and westbound exit slip roads at Junction 38;
- (iii) the A63 eastbound and westbound entry and exit slip roads at the A1034 South Cave Interchange;
- (iv) the A63 eastbound and westbound entry and exit slip roads at Welton Interchange;
- (v) the A63 eastbound and westbound entry and exit slip roads at Melton Interchange;
- (vi) the A63 eastbound and westbound entry and exit slip roads at the A15 Western Interchange;
- (vii) the A63 eastbound and westbound entry and exit slip roads at Priory Way Interchange;
- (viii) the A63 eastbound and westbound entry and exit slip roads at the A1166 Brighton Street Interchange;

- (ix) the A63 eastbound and westbound entry and exit slip roads at Daltry Street Interchange;
- (x) the A63 eastbound exit and westbound entry slip roads at the A1079 Mytongate Gyratory; and
- (xi) the A63 eastbound exit and westbound entry slip roads at the A1033 Mount Pleasant Interchange;

"footway" means a way comprised in a highway which also comprises a carriageway, being a way over which the public have a right of way on foot only;

"the works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 1st July 2013 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the eastbound carriageway, westbound carriageway or a slip road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the works period, enter or proceed in the footway adjacent to the A63 eastbound carriageway from a point 1007 metres west of the nose of the eastbound exit slip road at South Cave Interchange eastwards for a distance of 620 metres.
- **5.** The provisions of article 3 and 4 of this order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used for the purpose specified in paragraph (a) of this article.
