## ROAD TRAFFIC

# The M5 Motorway (Junction 9 to Junction 8) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 21st June 2013

Coming into force - - 28th June 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway ("the M5"), and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that Motorway and one of those connecting roads, in the Counties of Worcestershire and Gloucestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junction 9 to Junction 8) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 28th June 2013.

#### 2. In this Order -

"the motorway" means the northbound carriageway of M5 from its

junction with the exit slip road at Junction 9 to its junction

with entry slip road at Junction 8;

"the slip road" means slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of

the M5 at Junction 9;

"the works period" means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 1st

July 2013 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or the slip road.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
  - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
  - (c) being used for or in connection with the said works, or by a traffic officer in uniform.
