The A46 Trunk Road (Kenilworth, Warwickshire) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

 1st July 2013

 Coming into force
 8th July 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road ("the A46") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those connecting roads, near Kenilworth in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A46 Trunk Road (Kenilworth, Warwickshire) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 8th July 2013.

2. In this Order:

"a slip road" means any slip road leading to or from the A46 at its roundabout junction with the A452 near Kenilworth;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 15th

July 2013 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
