The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Dawlish) Regulations 2013

 Coming into force
 24th August 2013

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Dawlish, Devon by reason of the holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place there on 24th August 2013.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Dawlish) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 24th August 2013.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Restricted airspace

- **3.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) between 1000 hours and 1500 hours on 24th August 2013 no aircraft is to fly below 5,000 feet above mean sea level within the area of a circle having a radius of 3.5 nautical miles whose centre is at 503443N 0032741W.
- (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the prior permission of the Dawlish Air Show flying display director.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Dawlish, Devon, on the occasion of an air show that will be held along the seafront and over the sea at Dawlish on 24th August 2013. A number of civil and military aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the event. The Civil Aviation Authority considers that flying should be restricted during the air show in the vicinity of Dawlish for reasons of public safety and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(2), the Dawlish Air Show flying display director may be contacted on telephone 07894 538401.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by NOTAM.
