ROAD TRAFFIC

The A40 Trunk Road (Huntley to Boxbush, Gloucestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A40 Trunk Road ("the A40"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Huntley and Boxbush in the District of Forest of Dean in the County of Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A40 Trunk Road (Huntley to Boxbush, Gloucestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 25th July 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the A40" means the A40 from the centre of its junction with the A4136 Longhope Road, Huntley, to the centre of its junction with Church Road at Churchfield Wood;

"the local road" means Hinders Lane leading to and from the A40 near Huntley;

"the works" mean ground investigation survey works;

"a works period" means a period of 14 hours starting at 06.00 hours on Saturday 27th July 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A40.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A40 at its junction with the local road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works;

(d) vehicles proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A40 or the local road.
