The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Shoreham-by-Sea) (Amendment) Regulations 2013

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Shoreham-by-Sea, West Sussex, by reason of the intended holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place there on 31st August and 1st September 2013.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Shoreham-by-Sea) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 31st August 2013.

Amendment

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Shoreham-by-Sea) Regulations 2013(**b**) are amended as follows.

Restricted airspace

- **3.**—For Regulation 3(1), substitute—
 - "3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 0930 hours and 1700 hours on 31st August and 1st September 2013, no aircraft is to fly below 5,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 3.5 nautical miles whose centre is at 505008N 0001750W."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Shoreham-by-Sea) Regulations 2013 (S.I. 2013/1130) ("the principal Regulations"). The amendment makes changes to the timing and upper limit of the flying restrictions applicable under the principal Regulations in relation to the Shoreham-by-Sea air show that will be held on 31st August and 1st September 2013.

Full details of the restricted airspace will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
