## ROAD TRAFFIC

The A2 Trunk Road (Guston Roundabout – Dover Eastern Docks Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 22nd July 2013

 Coming into force
 10th August 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A2 Trunk Road (Guston Roundabout – Dover Eastern Docks Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 10th August 2013 and shall apply for a period of eighteen months.

## 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A2 Trunk Road (Jubilee Way) near Dover in the County of Kent;

"the length of carriageway" means both carriageways of the trunk road (Jubilee Way) between Guston roundabout (A258) and Dover Eastern Docks roundabout (A20);

"works" mean refurbishment works at Eastcliff Viaduct;

"a works period" means a period of 24 hours starting at 0001 hours on Monday 12th August 2013 or on any subsequent day until 9th February 2015.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
