## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A12 Trunk Road (Langham, Colchester, Essex) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 5th August 2013

Coming into force - - 12th August 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road ("the A12"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Essex should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Langham, Colchester, Essex) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 12th August 2013.
  - 2. In this Order -

"the trunk road" means the northbound carriageway of the A12 at Langham;

"bus stop area" means an area of carriageway on a side of the trunk road intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions (b);

"works" mean drainage investigation at Park Lane, Langham;

"a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 19th August 2013 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday) until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter the -
  - (a) trunk road from its junction with Park Lane, Langham, or
  - (b) bus stop area adjacent to the trunk road situated between the exit and entry slip roads leading to and from Park Lane, Langham.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used in connection with the works or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform.
