## ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A38 Trunk Road (Chudleigh to Splatford, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 13th August 2013

 Coming into force
 17th August 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and some of those connecting roads in the District of Teignbridge in the County of Devon should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Chudleigh to Splatford, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 17th August 2013.

#### 2. In this Order -

"the A38" means (i) the eastbound carriageway of the A38 from the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at the Chudleigh Station Junction to the tip of the nosing of the eastbound entry slip road at the B3344 Harcombe Junction; and (ii) the westbound carriageway of the A38 from the tip of the nosing with the A380 westbound at the Splatford Junction to the tip of the nosing of the westbound entry slip road at the Chudleigh Station Junction:

"the slip roads" mean (i) the eastbound entry slip road at the A38 Chudleigh Station Junction; (ii) the westbound entry slip road at the A38 Belvedere Cross Junction; and (iii) the westbound entry slip road at the A38 Harcombe Back Lane Junction;

"tip of the nosing" means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean bridge maintenance and other maintenance works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 19th August 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A38 and the slip roads.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
  - (c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
