### ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A40 Trunk Road (M5 Junction 11) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2013

Made - - - - 13th August 2013

Coming into force - - 17th August 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A40 Trunk Road ("the A40"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the District of Tewkesbury in the County of Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A40 Trunk Road (M5 Junction 11) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 17th August 2013.

#### 2. In this Order -

"the A40" means the westbound carriageway of the A40 at M5 Junction 11 between the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road to the junction roundabout and the tip of the nosing of the westbound entry slip road from the junction roundabout;

"tip of the nosing" means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean resurfacing, joint repairs and road marking works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 20th August 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A40.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) a vehicle being used at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable or traffic officer in uniform:

(c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
