ROAD TRAFFIC

The A556 Trunk Road (M6 Junction 19 Roundabout to Mere Crossroads Northbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 13th August 2013

Coming into force - - 1st September 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A556 Trunk Road is satisfied that traffic on a section of that trunk road in Cheshire East should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A556 Trunk Road (M6 Junction 19 Roundabout to Mere Crossroads Northbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 1st September 2013.

2. In this Order;

"the trunk road" means the A556 Trunk Road;

"works" means small works scheme and routine maintenance on the trunk road;

"the works period" means two nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours (continuing to 0700 hours on Saturdays and Sundays) during a period starting on Monday 2 September 2013 and ending on Saturday 28 September 2013. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the length of carriageway" means the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from a point where the centre point of the A556 meets the circulatory carriageway of the A556/M6 Junction 19 roundabout. The closure of the A556 northbound carriageway will end at the centreline of the junction of the trunk road with the A50 Warrington Road (the western approach to the A556).

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

4.	The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent
	as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
	being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services,
	vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle
	proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in
	uniform.
