## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A38 Trunk Road (Marsh Mills Junction, Plymouth) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 21st August 2013

Coming into force - - 24th August 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads at Plymouth in the County of Devon should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Marsh Mills Junction, Plymouth) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 24th August 2013.
  - 2. In this Order –

"the slip roads" mean (i) the westbound exit slip road of the A38 at Marsh Mills junction; and (ii) the eastbound entry slip road of the A38 at Marsh Mills junction.

"the works" mean road improvement and maintenance works;

"a works period" means a period of 11 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Tuesday 27 August 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
