Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Care Quality Commission (Membership) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 1st October 2013.

2. In regulation 2 of the Care Quality Commission (Membership) Regulations 2008(**2**), for "not more than twelve" substitute "not more than fourteen".
