ROAD TRAFFIC

The A36 Trunk Road (Churchill Way, Salisbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2013

 Made
 27th August 2013

 Coming into force
 31st August 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road ("the A36") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and one of those connecting roads in Salisbury in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Churchill Way, Salisbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 31st August 2013.

2. In this Order -

"the A36" means (i) the northbound carriageway of A36 Churchill Way East in Salisbury between College Roundabout and St Mark's Roundabout; and (ii) the southbound carriageway of A36 Churchill Way North in Salisbury between Castle Roundabout and St Mark's Roundabout:

"the slip road" means the westbound entry slip road at the A36 Culvert Street / Rampart Road Junction;

"the works" mean resurfacing, loops and road marking works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 2nd September 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A36 and the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (d) a vehicle proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A36.
