ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Ranby, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic in Layby) Order 2013

Made 19th August 2013

Coming into force - -26th August 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road ("the A1"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Ranby in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Ranby, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic in Layby) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 26th August 2013.

2. In this Order –

"layby"

means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Sunday 1st September 2013 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.
