ROAD TRAFFIC

The M62 Motorway (Junction 37 and Junction 38) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 5th September 2013

Coming into force - - 15th September 2013

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway and connecting roads, in the East Riding of Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads should be and prohibited because carriageway resurfacing, pavement renewal, electrical installation, road making, stud renewal and routine maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a): -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Junction 37 and Junction 38) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 15th September 2013.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the M62 Motorway:
 - (i) eastbound and westbound entry and exit slip roads at Junction 37 (Howden) during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 16th September 2013, or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed; or
- (ii) westbound entry slip road at Junction 38 (North Cave) during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 23rd September 2013, or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
