ROAD TRAFFIC

The A38 Trunk Road (Exeter Race Course, Haldon (also known as Belvedere Cross) and Chudleigh, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the District of Teignbridge in the County of Devon should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public during the Tour of Britain Cycle Race near Exeter Racecourse, Haldon, and Chudleigh, Devon.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Exeter Race Course, Haldon (also know as Belvedere Cross) and Chudleigh, Devon) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 18th September 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the slip roads " mean (i) the southbound exit slip road of the A38 at Exeter Race Course, the C19 to Dunchideock, and (ii) the southbound and northbound exit slip roads at the A38 Chudleigh junction with the B3344

"the period of danger" means the period starting at 13.00 hours on Friday 20th September 2013 and ending when the likelihood of danger to the public from the Tour of Britain cycle race is over.

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the period of danger, cause any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes
- (b) or proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
