ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road (Skellingthorpe Roundabout to Carholme Roundabout, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 9th September 2013

Coming into force - - 16th September 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road ("the A46"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the County of Lincolnshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Skellingthorpe Roundabout to Carholme Roundabout, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 16th September 2013.

2. In this Order:

"Skellingthorpe Roundabout" means the A46/B1378/Lincoln Road roundabout junction, near Skellingthorpe; "Carholme Roundabout" means the A46/A57 roundabout junction west of Lincoln; "the first length of trunk road" means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A46 from Skellingthorpe Roundabout to Carholme Roundabout: means the northbound carriageway of the A46 from "the second length of trunk road" Skellingthorpe Roundabout to Carholme Roundabout; "the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 20th September 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the second length of trunk road.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
 - **6.** The provisions of
 - (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
 - (b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and
 - (c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
