ROAD TRAFFIC

The M56 Motorway (Junctions 4-5 Eastbound and Westbound Entry and Exit Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)

Order 2013

Made - - - - 25th September 2013

Coming into force - - 28th September 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M56 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on three of those slip roads in the District of Manchester in the Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M56 Motorway (Junctions 4-5 Eastbound and Westbound Entry and Exit Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 28th September 2013.

2. In this Order;

"the motorway" means the M56 Motorway;

"works" means kerbing, road marking, stud, drainage and maintenance works on the slip roads;

"the works period" means seven nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours (continuing to 0700 hours on Saturday and Sunday mornings) during a period starting on Sunday 29 September 2013 and ending on Friday 25 October 2013. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the first slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 4;

"the second slip road" means the exit slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 4.

"the third slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 5;

- 3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first, second and third slip roads.
- 4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
