ROAD TRAFFIC

The A49 Trunk Road (Dinmore Hill, Herefordshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 27th September 2013

Coming into force - - 4th October 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road ("the A49") is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Dinmore Hill in the District of the County of Herefordshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Dinmore Hill, Herefordshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 4th October 2013.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the

A49 between a point 1566 metres north of its junction with Orchard Green near Wellington and its junction with the entrance to Queenswood Country Park, approximately 1750 metres south of the junction of the A49 and A417;

"the works period" means the period starting at 09:00 hours on Saturday 5th

October 2013 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- 3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
 - 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or special forces purposes; or(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
