## ROAD TRAFFIC

The A30 Trunk Road (Temple, Near Bodmin to Plusha, Near Launceston, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 10th October 2013

Coming into force - - 19th October 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road between Bodmin and Launceston in Cornwall should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Temple, Near Bodmin to Plusha, Near Launceston, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 19th October 2013.

## 2. In this Order –

"the A30" means the eastbound carriageway and the westbound carriageway of the A30 from a point 50 metres east of the centre of Temple Cross junction to the centre of Plusha junction;

"the works" mean drainage improvement works;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 21st October 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the A30.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
- **5.** No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
