ROAD TRAFFIC

The A120 Trunk Road (Marks Farm Roundabout Braintree, Essex) (Temporary 40 Miles Per Hour and 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A120 Trunk Road ("the A120") is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Essex should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A120 Trunk Road (Marks Farm Roundabout Braintree, Essex) (Temporary 40 Miles Per Hour and 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 21st October 2013.

2. In this Order –

"works" mean laying of new road markings and installation of traffic signs on the approaches to, and circulatory carriageway of, Marks Farm Roundabout;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 28th October 2013 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving vehicle or be driven on the A120 at a speed exceeding –

- (a) 50 miles per hour between its junction with Galleys Corner Roundabout and a point 400 metres south of its junction with Marks Farm Roundabout, or
- (b) 40 miles per hour between points 400 metres south and 300 metres east of its junction with Marks Farm Roundabout.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
- (b) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or

(c) falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
