## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The M42 Motorway (Junction 9) (Southbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway ("the M42") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads at Curdworth, in the County of Warwickshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M42 Motorway (Junction 9) (Southbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 21st October 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the slip road"	means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 9;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Friday 25th October 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the slip road.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the slip road.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

**6.** The provisions of –

- a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
- b) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
