ROAD TRAFFIC

The A45 Trunk Road (Rushden, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 14th October 2013

Coming into force - - 21st October 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road ("the A45"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Rushden in the County of Northamptonshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Rushden, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 21st October 2013.

2. In this Order -

"the slip road" means the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway

of the A45 from its roundabout junction with the A5001

Northampton Road at Rushden;

"pedal cycle" has the meaning given in regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs

Regulations and General Directions 2002 (b);

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 25th


October 2013 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the slip road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any person using a pedal cycle to enter or proceed in the cycle lane adjacent to the slip road.

- **6.** The provisions of
 - (a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (iii) used in connection with the said works; and
 - (b) article 4 shall not apply to any person
 - (i) engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activity; or
 - (ii) engaged in activity connected with the works.
