ROAD TRAFFIC

The A428 Trunk Road (Madingley, Cambridgeshire) Eastbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 28th October 2013

Coming into force - - 4th November 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A428 Trunk Road ("the A428") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road and on one of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A428 Trunk Road (Madingley, Cambridgeshire) Eastbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 4th November 2013.

2. In this Order -

"the slip road" means the exit slip road from the eastbound carriageway of the A428 to the A1303 at Madingley;

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**); and in this definition "carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"tip of the nosing" means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of the trunk road;

"works" mean CCTV drainage survey, topographical survey, soil sample collection, drainage works, soft estate and lighting maintenance and any other associated maintenance works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 11th November 2013 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday) until the works have been completed;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Sunday 10th November 2013 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter –

- (a) or proceed in the slip road, during a works period, or
- (b) the lay-by adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of the A428 situated approximately 630 metres west of the tip of the nosing of the slip road, during the works period.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
