ROAD TRAFFIC

The A12 Trunk Road (Kelvedon, Essex) Northbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 28th October 2013

Coming into force - - 4th November 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road ("the A12") is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road in the District of Colchester in the County of Essex, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Kelvedon, Essex) Northbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 4th November 2013.

2. In this Order:

"the tip of the nosing" means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the trunk road:

"the trunk road" means the A12 northbound carriageway between the tips of the nosings of the exit slip road at Junction 23 Kelvedon (South) Interchange and the entry slip road at Junction 24 Kelvedon (North) Interchange;

"a works period" means a period of –

- (a) 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Wednesday 6th November 2013, or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday), or
- (b) 13 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Saturday 9th November 2013, or on any subsequent Saturday,

until the works have been completed;

"works" mean inspection and survey of damaged beams on Ewell bridge;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, or
- (d) requiring access to or from properties which are accessible to, and from, the trunk road.
