ROAD TRAFFIC

The A30 Trunk Road (Innis Downs to Callywith, Near Bodmin) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and some of those connecting roads near Bodmin in Cornwall should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Innis Downs to Callywith, Near Bodmin) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 4th November 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the A30" means (i) the eastbound carriageway of the A30 between the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at the Innis Downs Junction and the tip of the nosing of the eastbound entry slip road at the Callywith Junction, Bodmin; and (ii) the westbound carriageway of the A30 between the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at the Callywith Junction, Bodmin, and the tip of the nosing of the westbound entry slip road at the Innis Down Junction;

"the slip roads" mean (i) the westbound entry slip road at the A30 Carminow Junction, Bodmin; and (ii) the eastbound entry slip road at the A30 Innis Downs Junction, near Bodmin;

"tip of the nosing" means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean the installation of a reconductor overhead high voltage line;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Wednesday 6th November 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A30 and the slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
