**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A36 Trunk Road (Bath to Warminster) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - 30th October 2013

*Coming into force* - - 2nd November 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road (“the A36”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in Bath and North East Somerset, in the County of Somerset and in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Bath to Warminster) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 2nd November 2013 and apply for a period of twelve months.

2. In this Order –

“the A36” means the A36 from the centre of its junction with Bathwick Street in Bath to the northern edge of the A350 roundabout near Warminster;

“the works” mean routine maintenance works including gully cleaning, barrier retensioning, grass cutting, sweeping, road markings, studs, carriageway patching and general maintenance works;

“a works period” means a period of 8½ hours starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 4th November 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A36.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes;
- (d) a vehicle proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A36.
