ROAD TRAFFIC

The A63 Trunk Road (Garrison Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2013

Made	-	7th November 2013
Coming into force	-	17th November 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A63 Trunk Road in the City of Hull, in the County of East Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be prohibited because traffic signs renewal works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A63 Trunk Road (Garrison Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 17th November 2013.

2. In this Order "footway" means a way comprised in a highway which comprises a carriageway, being a way over which the public have a right of way on foot only;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 08:00 hours on 18th November 2013 or any subsequent Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday thereafter until the said works are completed, cause or permit any person to enter or proceed in a footway adjacent to the A63 Trunk Road between Queen Street/Market Place and the Garrison Road/Great Union Street roundabout.

4. The provisions article 3 of this order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable in uniform;

and nothing article 3 of this order shall apply to any person engaged or assisting in the said works, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable in uniform.
