ROAD TRAFFIC

The A36 Trunk Road (Heytesbury to Deptford Junction, Wiltshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road ("the A36") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads between Heytesbury in the District of West Wiltshire and Deptford Junction, at Salisbury, in Wiltshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Heytesbury to Deptford Junction, Wiltshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force 30th November 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the A36" means (i) the southbound carriageway of the A36 between the eastern edge of Cotley Roundabout, Heytesbury and the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road from the A303 at Deptford Junction, Wylye and (ii) northbound carriageway of the A36 between the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road to the A303 westbound at the Deptford junction, Wylye and the eastern edge of the Cotley Roundabout, Heytesbury;

"the slip roads" mean (i) the A36 northbound entry slip road from the eastbound carriageway of the A303 and (ii) the A36 northbound entry slip road from the westbound carriageway of the A303, both at the Deptford Junction, Wylye.

"tip of the nosing" means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a motorway or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a motorway;

"the works" mean resurfacing and road marking works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 2nd December 2013 or on any subsequent night and ending when the said works have been completed;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 2nd December 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A36 or the slip roads.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the A36.

5.The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction or with the permission of a constable.

6. The provisions of articles 3 shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes;
- (b) vehicles proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A36.

7. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
