ROAD TRAFFIC

The A21 Trunk Road (Stonecrouch) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - - *25th November 2013*
Coming into force - - - *14th December 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A21 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road and prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A21 Trunk Road (Stonecrouch) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 14th December 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A21 Trunk Road in the County of Kent;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between Church Lane and a point 50 metres south of Rosemary Lane;

“an access road” means Rosemary Lane side access to the trunk road at Stonecrouch;

“works” mean resurfacing, road marking and all associated carriageway works on the trunk road; and

“the works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 16th December 2013 and ending on 13th June 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in an access road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

(a) 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed; or

(b) 40 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that length of road are not displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (a) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (d) a vehicle proceeding in the length of trunk road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.

(2) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
