ROAD TRAFFIC

The M5 Motorway (Junctions 4 to 3 Northbound) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway ("the M5"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway, in the County of Worcestershire and the Metropolitan Borough of Dudley, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**) and regulation 16(2) of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(**b**), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junctions 4 to 3 Northbound) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 1st December 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the motorway"	means the northbound carriageway of the M5 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 4 to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 3;
"the Regulations"	means the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982;
"a hard shoulder"	means the hard shoulder, within the meaning of Regulation 3(1)(e) of the Regulations, which is adjacent to the motorway;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 21.00 hours on Tuesday 3 rd December 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used for special forces purposes.

6. During the works period, regulations 5 and (in so far as it relates to a vehicle being driven) 9 of the Regulations are hereby suspended in respect of a hard shoulder, at such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
