ROAD TRAFFIC

The A52 Trunk Road (Queens Drive Flyover, Nottingham) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - 28th January 2013

Coming into force - -4th February 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road ("the A52") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads in the City of Nottingham should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Queens Drive Flyover Nottingham) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 4th February 2013.

2. In this Order:

"the link road" means the link road leading from the northbound

carriageway of the A52 Clifton Boulevard to the

eastbound carriageway of the A453 Queens Drive;

"the slip road" means slip road leading from the northbound carriageway

of the A52 to its roundabout junction with the A453 and

Lenton Lane (Queens Drive Roundabout);

"the works period" means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 11th

February 2013 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road or the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- **5.** The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle

 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (c) being used in connection with the said works.
