ROAD TRAFFIC

The A550 Trunk Road (Welsh Road, Shotwick Northbound and Southbound Carriageways) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2013

Made - - - - 10th December 2013

Coming into force - - 14th December 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A550 Trunk Road is satisfied that traffic on sections of that road in the District of Cheshire West and Chester in the County of Cheshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A550 Trunk Road (Welsh Road, Shotwick Northbound and Southbound Carriageways) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 14th December 2013.
 - 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A550 Trunk Road:

"works" means replacement of an overhead line conductor on the trunk road;

"the first length of carriageway" means the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from its junction with the A494 to its junction with the A540 at Two Mills;

"the second length of carriageway" means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road from its junction with the A540 at Two Mills to its junction with the A494;

"the works period" means a period between 0800 hours and 1000 hours on Sunday 15 December 2013. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent Sundays, or continue until completed for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first and second lengths of carriageways.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
