## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The M5 Motorway (Junction 15, Almondsbury Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway ("the M5") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads at Junction 15 in South Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junction 15, Almondsbury Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 16th December 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the slip road" means the slip road leading from the M5 northbound to the M4 eastbound at Almondsbury Interchange (the 'G' loop);

"the works" mean resurfacing, white lining and studs work;

"a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Wednesday 18th December 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes.
