## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A2 Trunk Road (A28 Interchange, Slip Road Closures) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 9th December 2013

Coming into force - - 4th January 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A2 Trunk Road (A28 Interchange, Slip Road Closures) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 4th January 2014.
  - 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A2 Trunk Road in the County of Kent;

"the slip road" means –

- (i) the road leading from the A28 (Thanington Road) to the coastbound carriageway of the trunk road at the A28 Interchange or
- (ii) the road leading from the Londonbound A2 to the A28 (Thanington Road) at the A28 interchange

"works" mean lantern replacement; and

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 4th January 2014 or on any subsequent day until 5th July 2015.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
  - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
  - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
