ROAD TRAFFIC

The A33 Trunk Road – A34 Trunk Road, Kings Worthy Link Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 16th December 2013

Coming into force - - 1st February 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A33 and A34 Trunk Roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A33 Trunk Road – A34 Trunk Road, Kings Worthy Link Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 1st February 2014.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A33 Trunk Road near Winchester in the County of Hampshire; "the link road" means -

- (i) the road leading to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from the A34 or
- (ii) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road to the A34 at Kings Worthy;

"works" mean carriageway repairs, resurfacing, drainage works and all associated work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 3rd February 2014 or on any subsequent day until Monday 31st July 2015.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or procede in the link roads.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
 - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
