## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The M62 Motorway (Junction 6 Westbound Link Road to the M57) and the M57 Junction 1 (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 and M57 Motorway and its slip road, is satisfied that traffic on the slip road in the District of Knowsley in Merseyside should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Junction 6 Westbound Link Road to the M57) and the M57 Junction 1(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 5th January 2014.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M62 Motorway and M57 Motorway;

"works" means cable fault rectification works near the motorway;

"the works period" means over night between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 6 January 2014 and ending on Saturday 11 January 2014. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the slip road" means the exit slip road leading to the A5300/M57 at Junction 1;

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the exit slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or for winter maintenance activities, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
