ROAD TRAFFIC

The A34 Trunk Road (Three Maids Hill Interchange – M3 Junction 9, Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A34 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A34 Trunk Road (Three Maids Hill Interchange – M3 Junction 9, Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 2nd March 2013.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A34 Trunk Road near Winchester in the County of Hampshire;

"the length of southbound carriageway" means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road between the slip road leading to the A272/B3420 at Three Maids Hill Interchange and the roundabout at the M3 Junction 9 (A33);

"a slip/link road" means –

- (i) the road leading from the A272/B3420 to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Three Maids Hill Interchange, or
- (ii) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A33 (Basingstoke Road) to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Kings Worthy;

"works" mean essential carriageway repairs and all associated work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 4th March 2013 or on any subsequent day until 1st September 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of southbound carriageway or a slip/link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
