## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A40 Trunk Road (Denham Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 11th February 2013

 Coming into force
 2nd March 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A40 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A40 Trunk Road (Denham Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 2nd March 2013.

## 2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A40 Trunk Road in the County of Buckinghamshire;

"a section of the roundabout" means -

- (i) the southeastern section of the trunk road at Denham roundabout (M40 Junction 1) between the slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road (Western Avenue) and its junction with the A4020 (Oxford Road), or
- (ii) the southern section of the trunk road at Denham roundabout (M40 Junction 1) between its junction with the A4020 (Oxford Road) and the A412 (Denham Road);

"works" mean carriageway resurfacing, road marking, stud reinstatement and all associated work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of -

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 4th March 2013 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 8th March 2013 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 9th March 2013 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iii) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 10th March 2013 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 1st September 2014.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a section of the roundabout.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
  - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
  - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
  - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
