## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A52 Trunk Road (Stapleford, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 1st March 2013

Coming into force - - 8th March 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road ("the A52"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Stapleford in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Stapleford, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 8th March 2013.

## 2. In this Order:

"layby" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of

vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a

suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Saturday 9th

March 2013 and ending when the said works have been

completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the laybys situated adjacent to
  - (a) the A52 eastbound carriageway 650 metres north of its roundabout junction with the B6003 (Bardills Island);
  - (b) the A52 westbound carriageway 170 metres south of its junction with the A6007 and B5010 (Bramcote Island); or
  - (c) the A52 westbound carriageway 1.6 kilometres south of its junction with the A6007 and B5010 (Bramcote Island).
- **4.** The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
  - (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
