ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Welton, Northamptonshire) (Temporary 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013

Made---4th March 2013Coming into force--11th March 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5") is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Welton in the County of Northamptonshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Welton, Northamptonshire) (Temporary 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 11th March 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road"	means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A5 between a point 800 metres north and 800 metres south of the centreline of the railway bridge carrying the A5 over the West Coast Mainline at Welton;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Thursday 14th March 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for special forces, police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
