The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 22 Brampton and Junction 24 Godmanchester, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road ("the A14"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 22 Brampton and Junction 24 Godmanchester, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 18th March 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road" means the A14 -

- (a) eastbound carriageway between points 400 metres west and 350 metres east of the centre point of the B1514 Thrapston Road bridge at Junction 22 Brampton and Huntingdon Racecourse Interchange, and
- (b) westbound carriageway between points 550 metres east of the centre point of the east bridge and 250 metres west of the centre point of the west bridge at Junction 24 Godmanchester Interchange;
- "works" mean installation of Incident Detection loops in the carriageway of the trunk road;

"a works period" means a period of 7 hours starting at 22.00 hours on Tuesday 19th March 2013 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform.
