## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A27 Trunk Road (East of Firle Road Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 11th February 2013

Coming into force - - 2nd March 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (East of Firle Road Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 2nd March 2013.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A27 Trunk Road (Lewes Road) in the County of East Sussex;

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**);

"the A27 lay-by" means the lay-by in the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road 29 metres east of the centre of Firle Road junction;

"works" mean footway renewal work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 13 hours starting at 1900 hours on Monday 4th March 2013 or on any subsequent day until 1st September 2014.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in, or wait on, the A27 lay-by.
- **4**. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - **5.** (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -
    - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
    - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
    - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
    - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
