ROAD TRAFFIC

The A2 Trunk Road (Ebbsfleet Junction – Pepper Hill Interchange, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A2 Trunk Road (Ebbsfleet Junction – Pepper Hill Interchange, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 2nd March 2013.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A2 Trunk Road near Northfleet in the County of Kent;

"a slip road" means -

- (i) the road leading to the Londonbound carriageway of the trunk road from the B262 (Hall Road) at Pepper Hill Interchange, or
- (ii) the road leading to the coastbound carriageway of the trunk road from Ebbsfleet Eastern roundabout;

"works" mean bridge repairs and associated works on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Friday 8th March 2013 or on any subsequent Friday, Saturday or Sunday until 1st September 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or

(d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
