# The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Balado) Regulations 2013

Made--9th April 2013Coming into force-11th July 2013

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Balado, Perth and Kinross, by reason of the intended gathering of a large number of persons at the T in the Park 2013 Music Festival which is scheduled to take place in the period from 11th to 15th July 2013.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order  $2009(\mathbf{a})$ .

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Balado) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 11th July 2013.

#### Interpretation

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

#### **Restricted airspace**

**3.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 0900 hours on 11th July and 1200 hours on 15th July 2013, no aircraft is to fly below 3,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 1.5 nautical miles whose centre is at 561248N 0032734W.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft operating with the permission of Inspector Katie Chisholm or Sergeant Ged McGouldrick of the Police Service of Scotland.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Balado, Perth and Kinross, by reason of the T in the Park 2013 Music Festival that is scheduled to take place there from 11th to 15th July 2013. A large gathering of people will attend this event on each day and therefore the Police Service of Scotland has requested that restrictions be imposed on flying in the vicinity of the music festival on public safety and security grounds. These have been agreed with the Civil Aviation Authority and the Department for Transport.

Full details of the restricted airspace will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
