## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M60 Motorway (Junction 23 Clockwise Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 27th February 2013

 Coming into force
 15th March 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the District of Tameside in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M60 Motorway (Junction 23 Clockwise Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 15th March 2013.

## **2.** In this Order;

"motorway" means the M60 Motorway;

"works" means maintenance works on the motorway slip roads;

"the works period" means periods overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours 9continuing to 0700 hours on Saturday and Sunday mornings) during a period starting on Friday 15 March 2013 and ending on Monday 25 March 213. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the entry slip road" means the entry slip road leading to the clockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 23;

- 3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
- 4. The provisions of articles 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
