ROAD TRAFFIC

The A36 Trunk Road (Bath to Warminster) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made---26th February 2013Coming into force-2nd March 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road ("the A36"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road between Bath and Warminster in Bath and North East Somerset and in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Bath to Warminster) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 2nd March 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the first length of the A36" means the A36 from the centre of its junction with Claverton Hill at Claverton Down to the centre of its junction with Brassknocker Hill near Monkton Combe;

"the second length of the A36" means the A36 near Warminster from the centre of its junction with Chalcot Lane to the northern edge of the A350 roundabout;

"the works" mean resurfacing, edge strengthening, joint repairs and road marking works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 4th March 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first length of the A36 and the second length of the A36.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;

(d) a vehicle proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A36.
