The M54 Motorway (Junction 6 to Junction 4) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013

 Coming into force
 15th March 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M54 Motorway ("the M54") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and one of those connecting roads, in the District of Telford and the Wrekin, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M54 Motorway (Junction 6 to Junction 4) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 15th March 2013.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway"

means the eastbound carriageway of the M54 from a point 46 metres west of the centreline of Waterloo Road underbridge near Ketley to a point 475 metres east of the centreline of the A5 overbridge near Telford Town Centre;

"the slip road"

means the slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the M54 at Junction 5, from a point 200 metres prior to its junction with the eastbound carriageway of the M54 to that junction;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Friday 22nd March 2013 and ending when the said works have been

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

completed:

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the motorway or the slip road.

- **4.** The provisions of articles 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
 - 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (iii) being used for special forces purposes.
