ROAD TRAFFIC

The A259 Trunk Road (King Offa Way/De La Warr Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 20th January 2014

Coming into force - - 8th February 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road and on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (King Offa Way/De La Warr Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 8th February 2014.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A259 (King Offa Way/De La Warr Road) Trunk Road in the County of East Sussex;

"central reservation" means that part of the trunk road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using that road.

"a side road" means -

- (i) the road leading to or from the western side of De La Warr Road at its junction with the westbound carriageway of the trunk road,
- (ii) the road leading to or from the northern side of Dorset Road at its junction with the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road,
- (iii) the road leading to or from the southern side of Dorset Road (A269) at it junction with the westbound carriageway of the trunk road,
- (iv) the road leading from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road at College Road junction, or
- (v) the road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road at Glyne Ascent junction;

"works" mean resurfacing, highways maintenance, street lighting, traffic sign installation and replacement work on the trunk road; and

"the works period" means the period starting on Monday 10th February 2014 and ending on 7th August 2015.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle
 - (a) to enter or proceed in a side road; or
- (b) to enter or proceed in the gap in the central reservation of the trunk road opposite its junction with the western side of De La Warr Road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
 - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
 - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
